The champion of Dr. Mario, who also played Farmville on a schedule, Pamela liked making birthday and holiday cards on her computer as well as knitting scarves and throws for gifts—with her dogs Fozzie and

Phoebe nestled by her side. More than anything, she was our “Ma,” who loved and cared for her family. She will be forever with us in our hearts.
