April 21, 1956 - September 18, 2015

Patrick M. Curby, 59, passed away September 18, 2015 in Diósd, Hungary while serving as a missionary with the Association of Baptists for World Evangelism. He was born April 21, 1956 in Cleveland, Ohio.

Pat has been a missionary with the Association of Baptists for World Evangelism (ABWE) since 1997. He previously worked in accounting and finance at Avery Denison in Concord Twp., OH. Sent from Willo-Hill Baptist Church in Willoughby, Ohio, as missionaries, Pat and Tina Curby were appointed by ABWE in July 1997. They arrived in Budapest with four of their five daughters in June, 2002. Pat was the regional financial director for the region of Central and Eastern Europe and the Mediterranean for over 10 years. He also served as the business manager for the International Christian School of Budapest, which included the oversight of a major school expansion project. Pat was an elder at Danube International Church and had been actively involved in the Matthew 25 Ministry, which recently expanded to include refugee ministry. Pat truly had a servant's heart with the gifts of helps and administration. He was always quick to cheerfully offer help in practical ways. His business background, analytical thinking, and care for all-things-logistical for regional conferences, leaders meetings, and other events were invaluable to his teammates. Pat always went about his work quietly and without drawing attention to himself. Hobbies of his included playing and coaching softball, watching sports, especially the Cleveland Indians and

Cleveland Browns, and Ohio State football. He enjoyed traveling with his wife and family, and spending time with his daughters. Pat graduated from Brookside High School in Sheffield Lake, OH class of 1974, Muskingum College in New Concord, OH in 1978 with a BA in Accounting, and earned his MBA at Ohio University in Athens, OH in 1980.

Survivors are his wife of 37 years Tina (Wagner) Curby; children Phan Mai "Lisa" (Edward) Csoltko, Anna Curby, Erin Curby, Allison (Michael) Wiltshire, and Cassie (Nate) Baird; grandchildren Mark, Daniel, and Nicole Csoltko; his sisters Marge LaHood and Judy (Ray) Arnold and many nieces, nephews, and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents Robert and Margaret (Keefe) Curby and his brother Robert Curby.

Funeral service will be held 12 noon Tuesday September 29, 2015 at Willo-Hill Baptist Church, 4200 Route 306, Willoughby, Ohio 44094. The family will receive friends from 10 a.m. until the time of the service on Tuesday at the church. Interment will be at Resthaven Memory Gardens, Avon, Ohio.
