September 29, 1931 - July 29, 2023

Patrick Morrison, age 91 of Euclid, passed away peacefully Saturday, July 29, 2023, at home surrounded by his family. He was born September 29, 1931, in Wheeling, West Virginia.

Patrick was a brilliant chemist who was awarded several United States patents for his research. He worked for Man-Gill Chemical and Magni, and later had his own consulting business. He also worked in a lab at Case Western Reserve University, where he mentored chemistry students.

Prior to becoming a chemist, Patrick retired from the U.S. Army. He was a paratrooper — despite a fear of heights that was as strong as his sense of humor — in the 82nd Airborne Division.

Patrick enjoyed checking his stocks, watching “Breaking Bad” and the many vacations he shared with his family. He was a prolific storyteller who could recite every detail of Bob Feller’s career and vividly describe interactions with Michael Douglas (on an airport walkway) and Chuck Norris (on a first-class flight).

Survivors include his wife of 54 years and the love of his life, Carol A. (Wrentmore) Morrison; daughters Heather (Neil) Juneja, Hallie Morrison and Erin (Kevin) Kleps; grandchildren Jacob, Nicholas and Addison Gasiewski,

and Brooklynn and Brayden Kleps.

Patrick was preceded in death by his parents, Howard Morrison and Kathleen Potts, and sister, Kathleen Doverspike.

A private family celebration of Patrick's life will take place at a later date.
