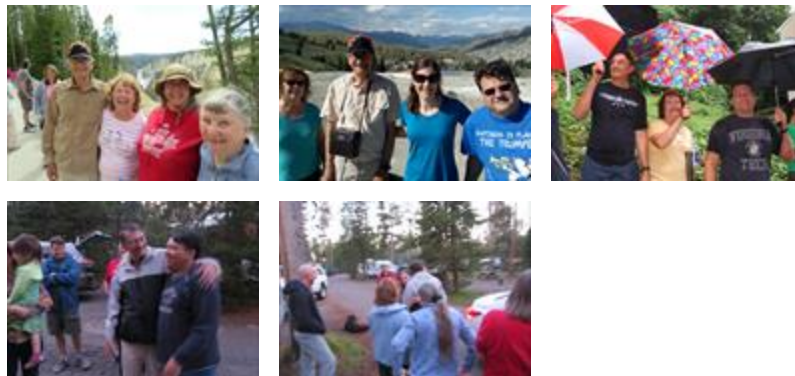

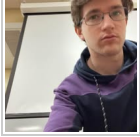

I only met Paul twice but was a friend of Pat. He seemed very easy to talk too and was a good listener, he was a kind and gentle soul and was was taken to soon

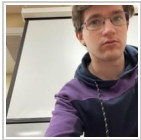
