Ralph C. Miller, age 87, passed away Tuesday, August 30, 2016 at Mentor Woods Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Mentor. He was born December 12, 1928 in Kirtland.

Mr. Miller was a 1946 graduate of Mentor High School. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps. and played the tuba in the military band while stationed at Mitchel Field, Hempstead, Long Island, NY. He was a Project Engineer with the Ohio Bell Telephone Company and also taught electronics at the Ohio Bell Plant Training facility in Cleveland.
