



## Raymond E. Hunziker, Jr

February 16, 1925 - March 14, 2016

Raymond E. Hunziker Jr., age 91 of Wickliffe, OH, formerly of Utica, NY, passed away Monday, March 14, 2016 at Hospice House in Cleveland, OH. He was born in Utica, NY on February 16, 1925.

Mr. Hunziker served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII as a Staff Sergeant with the 809th Field Artillery Battalion in the European Theater. He fought in the Battle of the Bulge as well as Remagen and was awarded the Purple Heart and Bronze Star. After WWII he remained in the reserves and was called back to active duty service during the Korean War. He graduated from Utica College with a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting and worked for General Electric, retiring in 1991 after 36 years. He was devoted to his family and gave selflessly of himself to his family and others and will be greatly missed.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years: Roseanne (nee: O'Neill) Hunziker; sons: Raymond E. Hunziker III, Richard J. Hunziker and Charles J. (Aimee) Hunziker; grandchildren: Daniel G. and Kathleen R. Hunziker and sister: Shirley Hunziker.

Preceding Raymond in death were his parents Raymond E. and Louise Hunziker Sr.

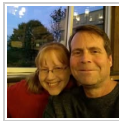
