Richard M. Bosich, 75, a longtime Mentor resident, passed away March 11, 2016. He was born October 12, 1940, in Fairbanks, PA.

Mr. Bosich was a prototype machinist at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland. After working there, he went to work for the Richmond Heights Police Department where he became a Sergeant. During his time as a police officer he was a member of the Hillcrest Area SWAT Team and a graduate of the FBI Academy in Quantico, VA. Richard ended his career as a prototype machinist in the Model Shop at General Electric, as a Group Leader. He was awarded a General Electric Patent for one of his engineering designs. A U.S. Army veteran, his hobbies included weight lifting, restoring cars, going to the shooting range and working with his mind and hands to visualize and create ideas that no one else could even imagine. He especially loved spending time with his English Bulldogs. As long as Richard and Carole were married, their love for each other always showed. Their marriage was an incredible love story and God blessed them both.
