Richard J. “Rich” Katona, age 86 of Concord Twp., passed away peacefully at home on Monday, February 20, 2023 with his family by his side. Born January 13, 1937 in Duquesne, PA, his family moved to Fairport Harbor where he attended Harding High. A stellar athlete, he excelled in many sports, especially baseball, basketball and football. He accepted a scholarship to play baseball at Kent State. Rich enrolled in the United States Army where he was trained as a medic and dental lab technician. He was a man of great faith, a devoted member of St. Gabriel Catholic Church, the Holy Name Society, and volunteered as a PSR teacher. Rich helped others see God’s love by the way he lived his life. A devoted husband and father, he always put family first. He was beacon of light, choosing to find the positive in every situation and was always the first to forgive. He was by far their biggest fan and attended as many of their sporting events as possible! He found true peace while tending to his lawn, raking leaves and other yard projects.
