



Robert W. "Bob" Jaynes

January 9, 1944 - October 27, 2014

Robert W. "Bob" Jaynes, age 70, of Concord for the past 15 years, formerly of Kirtland, died Monday October 27, 2014. He was born January 9, 1944 in Lakewood.

Mr. Jaynes was a Psychology Professor at Lakeland Community College, and a licensed Psychologist in the State of Ohio. Bob loved to make people laugh and was known for his jokes.

Survivors include wife, Dea Wells; stepdaughter, Hannah (Ronnie) Brehm of Mentor; granddaughter, Emma Mathis; siblings, Deborah (Michael) Jaynes Weir and Jonathon (Sally) Jaynes. Preceding Bob in death were his parents, Walter and Norma Jaynes.

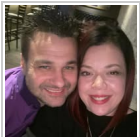
