Roger C. Sicker, 91, of Mentor, died September 18, 2022 at the David Simpson Hospice House in Cleveland. He was born August 20, 1931 in Coshocton, Ohio.

Mr. Sicker worked as a Vice President and Manager of Operations for Gould Electronics in Cleveland, Ohio for 30 years. His hobbies were boating, fishing, and golfing. He stayed up on current events and read the newspaper from cover to cover. He rooted on Mentor High School football, OSU football and the Cleveland Browns. He loved spending winters in Florida. Roger and his wife were members of Advent Lutheran Church for over 50 years.

Family gatherings were always a special time, especially if the family tradition of homemade ice cream was being made or clams were being steamed. He was a Navy Veteran during the Korean War. He talked fondly about how he separated the swimmers from the non-swimmers on the boat.

Survivors include his wife, Charlotte Sicker of 65 years; children, Karen (Keith – deceased) Ansley, Roger A. (Melinda) Sicker, Ronald Sicker, and David (Cheryl) Sicker; 12 loving grandchildren; and 5 loving great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Clarence and Josephine Sicker; and his sister, Dorothy Olinger.
