Sherrill A. Kuntz, 78, of Eastlake, died on December 11, 2022 at the Enclave of Newell Creek in Mentor. She was born on September 5, 1944 in Erie, PA.

Mrs. Kuntz lived a life of service and devotion to her faith and family. She was an active student at Harborcreek Senior High School in PA before attending Penn State University, where she met her husband, Gordon Kuntz, of 56 years.
