



## Steven Vincent Fiebig

April 20, 1978 - September 20, 2018

Steven Vincent Fiebig, better known to those close to him as Vince, 40, of Willoughby, formerly of Mentor and a long time resident of Kent, passed away peacefully on September 20, 2018 at his home after a 12 year battle with cancer. He was surrounded by his wife, sons, and loving family. There is no doubt that Steve and his brother Brian had front row seats on Thursday night to witness the Cleveland Browns win.

Steve and his twin brother Brian were born April 20, 1978 in Cleveland, Ohio to Tom and Virginia Fiebig. Steve was a 1996 graduate of Mentor High School where he lettered in football. After high school Steve went on to earn his Bachelors and Masters degrees from The University of Akron. He was a physical education teacher at OHDELA for the past 14 years where he touched the lives of thousands of children, as well as those he worked with.

Steve's sons, Cooper and Knox, were his pride and joy. He enjoyed spending time with them in any way, coaching them in sports and participating in their Boy Scout troop activities. Steve's bedtime routine always included telling his boys, "Always do your best."

Steve is survived by his wife, Wendy Fiebig (Waller); sons, Cooper and Knox Fiebig; his parents, Tom and Virginia Fiebig; mother-in-law, Sandy Allen, in-laws, Dave (Sandy) Waller, Jeff (Cheryl) Hunt, sister-in-laws, Kristen (Kevin) Kalinowski and Kate Waller, and nephews Ky and Kade Kalinowski. 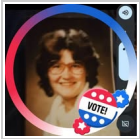

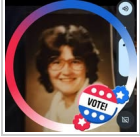
