Susan A. (Gromosky) Bonnett, age 65, of Cozumel, Mexico formerly of Macedonia, OH, died Tuesday May 19, 2015 at Governor's Point Assisted Living in Mentor, OH, She was born August 2, 1949 in Cleveland.

Susan was a hairdresser in the Bedford, OH, area for many years before she and her late husband James moved to Cozumel, Mexico. In Cozumel, Susan was known for her good works, which included enriching the lives of "her kids" in the neighborhood, helping to educate them and in some cases paying for their schooling.

For many years she worked for the Red Cross and served on the board. She started the Three King's Day, delivering toys and gifts to children in less fortunate neighborhoods. Susan frequently did craft projects with the residents of Juan Pablo II, Cozumel's elder care facility, and the list goes on and on.

Survivors include her mother Marian B. (Wilkes) Gromosky; siblings Laura E. (Roger Dickson) Gromosky, Nancy A. Szabados, Margaret E. (Deacon Ron) Adkins, Lawrence (Teri) Gromosky, Frank C. (Jennifer) Gromosky, Robert P. Gromosky and Joseph J. (Ande) Gromosky and many nieces and nephews. Preceding Susan in death was her husband James Bonnett and father Lawrence Gromosky.

The funeral mass will be 11:30 am Saturday May 30, 2015 at St. Gabriel Catholic Church, 9925 Johnnycake Ridge Rd. in Concord Twp, OH.
