January 3, 1949 - August 31, 2014

Suzanne B. Plumb, age 65, of Painesville Twp. for the past 13 years formerly of Mentor, died Sunday August 31, 2014 in the Seidmann Cancer Center at University Hospital, Cleveland. She was born January 3, 1949 in Columbia, Missouri.

Ms. Plumb was retired from her job as Executive Director for Crossroads Lake County Adolescent Counseling Services, a position she held for 19 years.

Suzanne received her Masters of Social Science in Administration Degree from Case Western Reserve University in 1977. Prior to that she received her Bachelor of Arts in Social Work from Indiana University in 1971. She was a graduate of Crown Point High School in Crown Point, Indiana, in 1967.
