Todd N. Loar, 73, of Montville and formerly of Chardon, died Aug. 20, 2013, at University Hospital in Cleveland. He was born at home July 19, 1940, in Alliance, to George and Rosalie (Wilson) Loar.

Mr. Loar founded Loar and Co. Insurance on Sept. 1, 1975, in Chardon. Todd loved his labradors, and enjoyed hunting and shooting.
