“ I was a Postulant in the Sisters of Charity of St. Augustion with Ginger. She was the leader of the group of 12 of us because she was the first one to sign up for that particular class. In reality, Ginger was our leader because she kept us all going with her energy and humor. I have been trying to remember Ginger's last name for many years. Today, as I prepare to move from my home of 45 yrs., I came upon a very old Christmas list and there was Ginger's name. I Googled her name and was very sad to see her obituary. I last saw Ginger in 1961 but I recognized her picture immediately. She was a force! I think she was the first to leave the postulancy. In those days, a postulant who left was gone suddenly. We were permitted no good-byes. One day, Ginger was there and the next day, she was gone. We were devastated. Before the year was up and it was getting time to make out first vows and "get the habit" about four of five of the original group of girls went home. I was among them. In the end, after several years, only one nun remained. I remember when we girls had to put in a Christmas show for the retired nuns. Toy Land was our theme. We worked very hard on the program and then presented it to Sr. Maura, the Mistress of Novices. She brought up something that we girls missed. We forgot to incorporate the birth of Jesus somehow in the Christmas show!!! Out of the group of twelve, nine of us were sent to St. John's College by the Cathedral. For some crazy reason, Ginger was not sent. She had to stay "home" with the two girls who acted like they were born nuns and our two top tattle tales. I brought Ginger movie magazines from the Cleve. Public Library to keep her abreast of big bad world out there. I am certain that Ginger, like me, were glad we went in the convent and even happier we left to marry, have children and grandchildren. Rest in Peace, Ginger.
