Wayne A. DiCenzi, age 67, of Mentor, passed away Monday, Jan. 26, 2015 at Hospice House.

He was born May 17, 1947 in Cleveland.

Wayne graduated from Shaw High School in 1965 and Lake Erie College in 1979 where he obtained his Bachelor of Science degree. A lover of traveling, shopping and tending to his vegetable garden, he was a 5th degree black belt in martial arts and a U.S. Navy veteran.
