



## Reverend Wilfred T. Smith

September 4, 1929 - August 25, 2016

Reverend Wilfred T. Smith, age 86, entered into rest August 25, 2016 at Jennings Home for older adults. He was born September 4, 1929 in Lakewood.

Ordained a priest for the Diocese of Cleveland in 1956. Emeritus Pastor at St. Mary of the Assumption (Mentor), and parochial vicar at St. Philip Neri, Holy Name, St. Robert (Euclid), St. Mary's (Wooster), St. Peter (Brookpark) and Immaculate Conception (Madison); frequent celebrant of Mass at the Lake County Fair and at Beaumont for the Boy Scouts.

He attended St. Christopher's Grade School in Rocky River, was a graduate of St. Ignatius High School, Class of 1947, St. Charles Borromeo, Catonsville, MD and St. Mary's Seminary, Cleveland. He was a member of Knights of Columbus, St. Mary of the Assumption Men's Club, Holy Name Society. A Jolly Fellows Classmate, card player, golfer, model railroader. A Faith-filled man who brought fun to many situations. We have been richly blessed.
